Grant Period Activities

The meeting consists of a session at Gordon Research Conference on Intermediate Filaments with the main focus of coordination of the four main Work Groups: [1] WG1 Biophysics of cell and tissue structure, [2] WG2 Structural analysis of biomolecules involved in mechanobiology, [3] WG3 New methodologies to study mechanobiology of cells and tissues, and [4] WG4 Mechanobiological principles of rare and common diseases. The meeting will give the opportunity to discuss the interaction of the Work Groups, early stage researchers, and international researchers. Attention will be brought also to the calls for ITC grants and STSMs. Furthermore, newcomers in the field will be welcomed and invited to actively participate in the WGs of EuroCellNet.
